


The New Plan...

One Representative

A year representative is a member of the GSC who represent their year group cohort.

They are responsible for collecting the feedback and results from the 'PV Feedback Friday' sessions and delivering results to the library.





One or two pupils from the GSC will be linked to each faculty area within the school.

They will attend one faculty meeting per term (approximately ten minutes) and discuss how faculties can implement any matters arising in the GSC meetings.

A small group of pupils who meet with other pupils to discuss any worries they might have. To organise 'drop in' meetings once a month where they are a 'friendly face' to all pupils within school.





A small group of pupils who promote LGBTQ +. To express concerns and report issues without judgement.

(Finance / Health and Safety / Eco)

Working in collaboration with support staff and governing body sub committee to work on targets for finance, health and safety and the Eco factors effecting the school.

They will be involved in planning whole school action plans, environmental school audits and carrying out initiatives in order to work towards green flag status.




'Senedd yr Ifanc' Wrexham Youth Parliament
